Career opportunities

Completion of this program does not satisfy the academic requirements for registration as a teacher in Queensland. However, students who complete the Graduate Diploma of Teaching program will be eligible to apply for registration for employment as teachers in schools in many jurisdictions, as well as in a range of alternative education settings.

Other career opportunities exist in the many emerging fields where the teaching-related skills of communication and educational management are critical, in conjunction with the appropriate specific discipline knowledge. Examples of such careers include sport and leisure centre management, personal training, life coaching and human services.

There are further career opportunities available in industry, particularly in the roles and functions related to training.

Program fees

Domestic full fee paying place

Domestic full fee paying places are funded entirely through the full fees paid by the student. Full fees vary depending on the courses that are taken. You are able to calculate the fees for a particular course via the [Course Fee Finder](#).

Domestic full fee paying students may be eligible to defer their fees through a Government loan called [FEE-HELP](#) provided they meet the residency and citizenship requirements.
