Program fees

Commonwealth supported place

Arts Studies

The Arts component shall comprise either:

- at least 12 courses comprising of an eight-unit major plus one 4-unit minor or 4 electives from the Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Communication or Bachelor of Creative Arts (students choosing majors from Bachelor of Creative Arts must contact the Faculty of Business, Education, Law and Arts as not all majors are available in this degree) or
- a 12-unit extended major from the Bachelor of Arts.

At least two units from each major must be at third year level.

Business Studies

The Business component shall comprise an eight-unit discipline-based major chosen from the following majors available within the Bachelor of Business:

- Administrative Management
- Human Resource Management
- Information Technology Management
- International Business
- Management and Leadership
- Marketing
- Supply Chain Management
- Tourism Management.

Required time limits

Students have a maximum of 9 years to complete this program.

Recommended enrolment pattern

Students are able to enrol in any offered mode of a course (on-campus, external or online), regardless of the program mode of study they enrolled in.

The following table indicates the preferred enrolment pattern for first year full-time/on-campus students. External or part-time students should follow a modified pattern.

Students should note the following:

- the Business major starts in Semester 1 of second year
- the first Arts major starts in Semester 2 of first year
- the second Arts major starts in Semester 1 of second year
- the three core courses CIS1000 Information Systems Concepts, CMS1000 Communication and Scholarship, STA2300 Data Analysis should be taken as indicated below but may be interchanged if there are timetable problems
- three of the Business core courses should be taken in Semester 1.
