students will be given full credit for all courses completed whilst studying the Postgraduate Diploma. Students must advise the Faculty in writing of their intention to articulate and this must occur prior to graduation from the Postgraduate Diploma of Mental Health Nursing.

Credit

Up to four exemptions may be applied for. However normally a student must complete at least six units of courses offered by USQ whilst enrolled in this program.
