Admission to the Bachelor of Business Administration is in accordance with [University's admissions policy](#) for undergraduate programs.

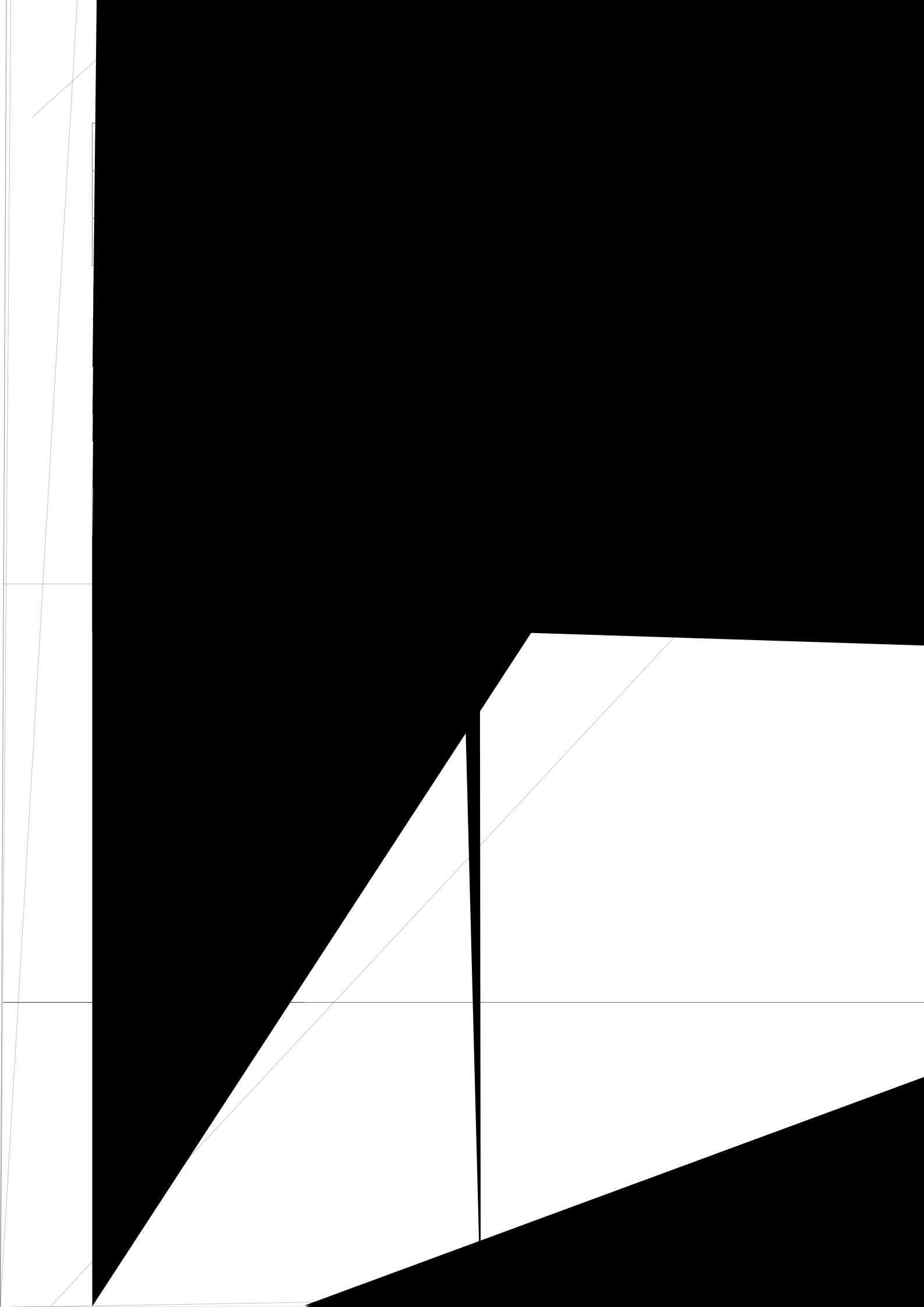
All students are required to satisfy the applicable [English language requirements](#).

## Exit points

Students must maintain good standing in this program (see Other program requirements section). Students not wishing to complete the Bachelor of Business Administration program may be permitted to exit with either the [Diploma of Business Administration](#) or the [Associate Degree of Business](#).

Students may exit with the [Diploma of Business Administration](#) if they have completed 8 courses as follows:

- a minimum of 4 courses from the [Bachelor of Business](#) core courses, and
- 4 other courses from the [Bachelor of Business](#).

Students may exit with the [Associate Degree of Business](#) if they have completed 16 courses as follows:

- 8 core courses from the [Bachelor of Business](#) or [Bachelor of Commerce](#), and
- any 8 courses from within the [Bachelor of Business](#)
