Program aims

The Graduate Diploma of Psychological Studies is available to graduates of disciplines other than Psychology. Entry into the [Bachelor of Science \(Honours\)](#) is competitive and not automatic.

Admission requirements

To be eligible for admission, applicants must satisfy the following requirements:

- hold a conferred Bachelors (or higher level) degree (in any discipline)
- have completed the pre-requisite courses listed below (or their equivalent elsewhere) within the last five years prior to commencing the program. These courses must be from an APAC accredited sequence of psychology study.
