Australian Qualifications Framework

The Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) is a single national, comprehensive system of qualifications offered by higher education institutions (including universities), vocational education and training institutions and secondary schools. Each AQF qualification has a set of descriptors which define the type and complexity of knowledge, skills and application of knowledge and skills that a graduate who has been awarded that qualification has attained, and the typical volume of learning associated with that qualification type.

Admission requirements

To be eligible for admission, applicants must satisfy the following requirements:

- Completion of an Australian university three (3) year Bachelor degree with a GPA of at least 4.0 out of 7.0, and a minimum of one year of professional work experience in business, or equivalent; or
- Completion of an Australian university three (3) year Bachelor degree, and a minimum of one and a half years of professional work experience in business, or equivalent.
- English Language Proficiency requirements for Category 3.

Candidates who have not completed an Australian university three (3) year Bachelor degree, but have a minimum of five (5) years professional work experience in business with at least one years' management or supervisory level experience, or equivalent, may apply for entry and be assessed on a case by case basis.

All students are required to satisfy the applicable English language requirements.

If students do not meet the English language requirements they may apply to study a University-approved English language program. On successful completion of the English language program, students may t of le

- The course was passed within 5 years prior to the application (courses up to 10 years old may be considered if evidence is provided that the applicant has been employed in that field).
- Where the student has taken out an award from a recognised tertiary institution, and is claiming credit
 on the basis of courses completed to meet the requirements of that program, the maximum credit on the
 basis of such courses shall be no greater than 2 courses for the Graduate Certificate of Business
 Administration.
